## **Health and Safety Clothing Essentials** ☐ Signed permission slip (collected before trip) ☐ Rain gear: poncho or rain suit, boots, hat ☐ Medication: labeled and given to First Aider ☐ <u>Jacket</u>, sweater, or sweat shirt or windbreaker ☐ Masks – enough for the duration of the trip ☐ Bandannas (2) **Basics Changes of Clothing** ☐ Class A Uniform worn during travel □ Underwear ☐ Waterproof duffel or backpack ☐ Long pants, shorts (preferably not jeans) ☐ Small day pack $\square$ Shirts – one long sleeve ☐ Water bottle w/lanyard (at least 32oz) □ Socks ☐ Sit-upon, camping chair ☐ Spare closed toed/heeled shoes ☐ Small Flashlight with spare batteries **Add for Cold Weather Events** ☐ Plastic bags for wet/dirty clothes ☐ Thermal underwear (preferably not cotton) **Sleeping Systems** ☐ Warm hat (mandatory) □ Waterproof ground cloth ☐ Insulation layer (closed cell foam pad) ☐ Mittens or gloves $\square$ Sleeping bag (nylon preferred, 30° to 40°) **Add for Swimming Events** ☐ Pajamas (two piece) □ Water shoes/old sneakers ☐ Pillow case to be stuffed with extra clothes □ Towel ☐ Warm hat (optional) ☐ Swim suit, sun hat **Eating Equipment** For Adults ☐ Unbreakable bowl, plate, cup (mess kit) ☐ Cell phone/camera/chargers ☐ Knife, fork, spoon (unbreakable) □ Whistle ☐ Mesh bag ☐ Key, combination, or other access to campsite Toilet Kit ☐ Matches or lighter ☐ Toothbrush, toothpaste ☐ Alarm clock or watch ☐ Washcloth, small towel, soap DO NOT BRING THE FOLLOWING ☐ Brush, comb, safety pins, hair ties **ITEMS** ☐ Tissues, lip balm X Scented soap/lotion/perfume ☐ Non-aerosol bug repellant X Gum, candy, or soda of any kind □ Sun block X Aerosol cans **Optional Items** X Glass containers (except Rx) X One piece pajamas or nightgowns □ Tent Helpful Hints ☐ Small games such as cards or marbles Dress in layers □ Pocket Knife Pack with first-used items on top $\Box$ 5' - 8' length of rope Shoes must be worn at all times ☐ Paper, pencil, songbooks, skits, crafts Pack and keep clothes in plastic bags at all times □ Compass Line duffel bag or backpack with plastic bag ☐ Small first aid kit No electronics!
